Conditional sentences let us express things that might or could have happened, could still happen, we wish could happen, or always happen in specific ...

Conditional Sentences: Examples and Definition

The mixed conditional describes present result of a past condition. Structure of Mixed Third/ Second Conditional. In this type of mixed conditional sentence, the tense in the 'if' clause is the past perfect, and the tense in the main clause is the present conditional. If + Past Perfect, Present Conditional (would/wouldn't + Verb (bare form)).
